



A “small cell” telecom transmitter generating 24/7 wireless radiation is coming to this neighborhood! We need your help to stop it! Once it’s up, there is little hope of ever having it removed!

The City of Santa Rosa is moving forward with permitting and encroachments for an application by AT&T for a 4G/5G wireless “small cell” tower/antenna on a PG&E pole at **287 Buena Vista Drive**. Studies have proven long term exposure of these wireless antennas (radiofrequency radiation) causes biological harm including physical damage at the cellular level. These wireless installations are being deployed with no concern for the health and well-being of people, wildlife, property values and privacy. There are also concerns that wireless transformers have been implicated in the start of fires!

The City has yet to adopt a comprehensive ordinance to control the placement of these Wireless Facilities. In addition, Telecom has not been asked to prove “a significant gap in coverage” which should be a requirement before any placement considerations. Don’t let our city proceed without public processes! Have you been notified of these pending compromises to your health, your property values, and your neighborhood aesthetics?

HERE’S WHAT YOU CAN DO:

Ask the city to prove a significant gap in coverage and proof of safety. Express your strong opposition to reduced property values, lack of notification, violation of privacy and ugliness/aesthetics (health alone doesn’t stand up against Telecom). You deserve to be safe in your home and neighborhood!
